Hedges are tall and managed. Field 2 comprises similar species to Field 1 but is slightly less diverse. Hypochaeris radicata is locally frequent /occasional. Luzula campestris is locally abundant, Primula veris, occasional. In Field 1, Sanguisorba minor was rare to locally occasional. 3 smaller fields to the west of the lodge were short mown, amenity grassland and are grazed by one horse. Field 1 is cut for hay once a year, not always in late summer. Owner is interested in meadow management; present management is favorable for Fields 1 and 2.
