Field 2 supports a good variety of species that typically includes frequent <i>Centaurea nigra</i> , <i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i> , <i>Ranunculus bulbosus</i> , together with occasional <i>Daucus carota</i> , <i>Hypochaeris radicata</i> and <i>Trifolium pratense</i> . Field 1 supports similar species though more locally distributed, with richness greatest in the north-west quarter of the field. The south of the field is poorer with <i>Plantago lanceolata</i> and <i>Taraxacum officinale</i> the major herbs and areas of bare ground. <i>Primula veris</i> are locally frequent in both fields particularly near the dividing hedgerow between the two where <i>Allium schoenoprasum</i> also occurs. The site is surrounded by fenced low hedgerows. <i>Taraxacum officinale</i> and <i>Bellis perennis</i> form a constant part of the swards.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
