The field to the north has a relatively steep southerly facing slope and is mainly on MG6 grassland habitat with a slightly richer MG5 area in the southern half. The compartment in the south - eastern part of the site is a mosaic of habitats that include MG5 grassland with a wetter area lining a stream that include M23a and M25b. The wetter element of the grassland continues further east with another stream and then a large area of MG5 grassland with a southerly facing slope. Site has many mature trees throughout the tall overgrown hedges that border it. Currently restricted management due to multiple ownership and lack of stockproof fencing.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
