WS/ST4 9/06	Kilgwrrwg House Meadow	ST403 983	0.52 ha	Neutral Grassland (MG6) Standing Water Running Water	Species- Rich Grassland (HAP)	A meadow situated adjacent to the garden of Kilgwrrwg House with an easterly facing slope but which towards the bottom becomes more northerly. The meadow has a good scattering of forbs. There are patches of bare ground in places and areas of ranker vegetation but management history is unknown. A pond that is well vegetated lies in the north western corner and is fed by a stream that runs down along the western boundary. Another pond has been dug on the eastern side but is not full of water yet. The field flattens out at the top and the grassland is quite dry although the ground is uneven in places. It is recommended the ponds are included in a Wildlife Site boundary. A mown path can be found around the meadow.	H4 Neutral Grassland
