Much if the vegetation is flushed, with smaller isolated drier areas particularly on the edges and towards the centre. The drier sward contains a short herbaceous MG5c community, with <i>Potentilla erecta, Danthonia</i> <i>decumbens, Sucissa pratensis</i> and <i>Leontondon autumnalis</i> . The damper grassland contains <i>Juncus effusus,</i> <i>Agrostis canina, Juncus acutiflorus,</i> <i>Ranunculus flammula, Mentha</i> <i>aquatica, Prunella vulgaris, Potentilla</i> <i>anserina, Potentilla erecta, Carex</i> <i>panicea</i> and <i>Cirsium palustre</i> : an M23 type community. A covered well exists on site, and a spring line is located at the edge of the scrub, in which the taller herbs <i>Angelica sylvestris</i> & <i>Epilobium hirsutum</i> are found.
