WS/ST49/15	Robinsons Meadows	ST468953	5.29 ha	Species-Rich Grassland Wet Woodland Broadleaved Trees Running Water Marshy Grassland	Species-Rich Grassland (HAP)	This site comprises two large fields with a diverse range of flora including a range of old meadow grasses and species characteristic of unimproved grassland (such as <i>Centaurea nigra</i> , <i>Rumex acetosa</i> and <i>Luzula campestris</i> ). Other common species included <i>Conopodium majus</i> , <i>Veronica chamaedrys</i> , <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> and <i>Hypochaeris radicata</i> . Hay cut in mid-July. The field slopes down to a small alder-lined stream, and in the smaller field a marshy area lies near the bottom. Extensive bramble removal has taken place alongside the stream and old tree-lines/hedgerows, opening them up for woodland flowers. Broad scalloped bands at the field edges have been planted with a range of broadleaved trees from a Woodland Grant Scheme about 5 years ago.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
