The grassland has a short, tight sward with a high cover of herbs, typically Centaurea nigra, Hypochaeris radicata, Leontodon hispidus, Lotus comiculatus, Carex caryophyllea and Euphrasia officinalis. Grass species common throughout are Agrostis capillaris, Festuca rubra and Cynosurus cristatus. In the damper area Juncus species, Carex panicea and Ranunculus flammula are present.
