Bushes Farm is located 2km west of Earlswood. The enclosures are all grazed but the northern and western fields are cut for hay. The fields are free-draining and support MG5 communities with agriculturally modified MG6; surrounding the brook is a small area of marshy grassland M23. The MG5a communities contain a good range of species which include Centaurea nigra, Carex caryophyllea, Leontodon autumnalis, Trifolium pratense and Leucanthemum vulgare. MG5c preferential species were recorded on site with Danthonia decumbens, Potentilla erecta & Succisa pratensis. The species-poor improved to semi-improved areas contain Lolium perenne, Trifolium repens & constant Cirsium arvense. The wetter grassland contains Juncus acutiflorus with Carex nigra & Carex panicea. Molinia caerulea is locally frequent. There was some Wahlenbergia hederacea close to the stream bank where poached.
