The fields are located on the eastern edge of Wentwood. The sward contains a herb-rich association of <i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i> , <i>Euphrasia</i> agg, <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i> , <i>Campanula rotundifolia</i> & <i>Hypochaeris radicata</i> . The sward has the appearance of being heavily grazed by horses and has many bare patches. Tall ruderal vegetation runs close to the field boundaries and <i>Senecio jacobea</i> is frequent in the upper-most field. There is also some <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> along the field edges.
