The field is bounded on all sides by hedgerows and an old track to the north. The grassland appears to have been abandoned although there are a couple of small ponds with associated tree planting. The sward is coarse and herb-rich with association of Centaurea nigra, Lotus comiculatus, Plantago lanceolata, Dactylorhiza sp, Lathyrus pratensis, Pimpinella saxifraga, Potentilla erecta, Carex caryophyllea and Knautia arvensis. Clumps of Pteridium aquilinium and Rubus fruticosus occur in the centre part of the field. The sward has the apperance of having not been cut or grazed in sometime as the coarse grasses have grown through a layer of dead vegetation. The western end of the site contains Arrhenatherum elatius and Dactylis glomerata characteristic of MG1. Lolium perenne occurs in the eastern end of the field.	H4 Neutral Grassland
