Grassland is tussocky, sward height 30cm, species-rich in places and the site is on a moderate to steep south-facing slope. There are remnants of a small traditional orchard to the western edge of the field and on the eastern edge there is scattered Hawthorn scrub (occasional) and <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> . Unmanaged gappy Hawthorn hedges to east and west boundaries are not stock proof and sheep can move easily between fields. The most diverse areas are on steeper sections at the middle and top of the slope. Species include frequent <i>Luzula campestris</i> and <i>Festuca rubra</i> , locally frequent <i>Achillea millefolium</i> , <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Conopodium majus</i> , <i>Hyacinthoides non-scripta</i> and <i>Trifolium pratense</i> , <i>Hypochoeris radicata</i> , <i>Centaurea nigra</i> and locally occasional <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i> and hawkbit sp. (Adjacent field to east is similar, has a fine grass sward but low herb diversity. Owned by Earlswood Chapel.)	H4 Neutral Grasslands
