The slopes associated with the knoll have limited herbaceous interest, largely limited to <i>Plantago lanceolata</i>, <i>Lotus corniculatus</i>, <i>Hypochaeris radicata</i> and <i>Ranunculus acris</i>, with <i>Trifolium repens</i> constant. Some areas are rather improved. The main interest lies with smaller areas of wet vegetation in the north and west associated with a stream/spring and areas of impeded drainage. 'Area A' supports frequent sedges (including <i>Carex panicea</i> and <i>Carex echinata</i>), <i>Juncus articulatus</i>, <i>Hydrocotyle vulgaris</i> and <i>Ranunculus flammula</i>. <i>Lychnis flos-cuculi</i> and <i>Lotus uliginosus</i> are occasional and a path of <i>Cirsium dissectum</i> is present. <i>Anagallis tenella</i> and <i>Pedicularis sylvatica</i> are also locally present. Towards the NE corner 'Area B' supports a mixture of wet and dry vegetation that includes <i>Dactylorhiza maculata</i>, <i>Potentilla erecta</i> and <i>Ulex europaeus</i>. Field 2 to the north has only limited interest in the wider sward, but again wetter areas raise the overall species diversity. Situated between field 1 and Coed Llifos WS is included within the proposed wildlife site boundary.</p>	H7 Marshy Grasslands Marshy areas are small but the quality and variety of species warrants consideration of the site as a "wildlife site".
