WS/ST49/33	Yew Tree Cottage, Gray Hill	ST436930	4.12 ha	S1 Neutral / Acid Grassland	Species-Rich Grasslands	Three fields situated on gentle-moderately sloping south facing slope situated to the south of Wentwood and Gray Hill enclosed by a mixture of fenced broken hedgelines and mature broadleaves. The site supports dry grassland with an acidic feel (despite failing to support sufficient acidic indicators as per wildlife site guidelines). Field 1 is characterised by frequent <i>Agrostis tenuis</i> , <i>Festuca rubra</i> , <i>Anthoxanthum odoratum</i> and <i>Holcus lanatus</i> . Typical herbs are <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Stellaria graminea</i> , <i>Plantago lanceolata</i> and <i>Luzula campestris</i> . Other herbs include <i>Trifolium pratense</i> , <i>Rumex acetosella</i> and <i>Hypochaeris radicata</i> are more localised. The west of the field is ranker and bracken is invading from north and south margins. Bracken is a significant problem in fields 2 and 3 with field 2 retaining only a small central area of open fine grassland of similar community type to field 1 but with <i>Potentilla erecta</i> more frequent. Field 3 exhibits localised richness over the lower half and includes a patch of <i>Campanula rotundifolia</i> . The north of the field is species-poor.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
