The sward is of variable quality with the greater interest and finer sward associated with southern half of site. <i>Centaurea nigra</i> , <i>Lathyrus pratensis</i> , <i>Stellaria graminea</i> , <i>Ranunculus acris</i> , <i>Lotus pedunculatus</i> are frequent-occasional through most of the sward, being joined towards the south by local <i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i> , <i>Luzula campestris</i> , <i>Leontodon hispidus</i> . Three <i>Dactylorhiza maculata</i> spikes also recorded. The north is taller and apparently unmanaged with hogweed and coarser grasses occurring more frequently. At the south a pond has recently been created and the banks are yet to vegetate. A mixture of outgrown hedges, mature trees and post and rail fencing enclose the site. Bracken and Bramble invade at some margins and some scattered saplings are present. Plantation Farm and the Gethlay SSSI and Plantation Farm Fields WS are situated to the east. | H4 Neutral Grasslands |
