Lower half of field is unmanaged, whilst top half is regularly mown. Despite <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> invasion a relatively rich neutral grassland sward survives in more open areas over the rest of the field. <i>Stellaria graminea</i> , <i>Centaurea nigra</i> and <i>Trifolium pratense</i> are frequent. <i>Potentilla erecta</i> is abundant, <i>Viola frequent</i> and <i>Galium saxatile</i> locally present giving an acidic feel. <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Pimpinella saxifraga</i> and <i>Plantago lanceolata</i> form an occasional part of the sward and both <i>Genista tinctoria</i> and <i>Succisa pratensis</i> are locally frequent in localised patches. Three <i>Dactylorhiza maculata</i> spikes recorded. The site is threatened from further <i>Pteridium aquilinum</i> invasion, which is extensive even in mown area.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
