The field is enclosed by deciduous woodland to the north, mixed hedgerow to the south. The field and its neighbour to the east were formerly part of the same management unit. They are now divided by a fence line and under different ownership, and management regimes. Effort was made to encourage the owners of the site to rather than managing as a lawn manage as a hay meadow like Walnut Tree Cottage which is visibly species-rich.	H4 Neutral Grasslands
