The old field boundaries have all but gone and the fields can be looked at as one entire field. The site is bordered by overgrown hedgerows. There is a public footpath through the centre of the site. The grassland generally contains a closely cropped acidic sward with some agricultural modification with <i>Lotus corniculatus</i> , <i>Rumex acetosella</i> , <i>Centaurea nigra</i> , <i>Potentilla erecta</i> , <i>Galium saxatile</i> and <i>Campanula rotundifolia</i> . The northern half of the field contains more improved grassland with MG5 becoming more prominent on the slope to the east.	H4 Neutral Grassland
