There are three fields on a gentle north facing slope. The grassland is dry with localised damper grassland to the eastern most field. All the fields have been recently topped. All the fields have MG5 type grassland characterised by frequent Cynosurus cristatus and Centaurea nigra. Field B has an area of grassland (which the owner said was ploughed post-WWI.) with Polygonum sp, Holcus mollis, and Ranunculus repens. Of particular importance is field C which has locally frequent Dactylorhiza fuchsii and Genista tinctoria with Galium saxatile, Danthonia decumbens, Potentilla erecta and Veronica officinalis. A large wet flush dominates field B and C with Juncus effusus, Juncus articulatus and Lotus sp. There is bracken encroachment in fields A and C. There are signs of ridge and furrow in all three fields as well as old banks. N.B. Species list provided in 2006 suggested fields A and B borderline. Resurveying in June 2007 suggests all fields warrant WS status as a single management unit. 2007 - Lovely group of fields managed as meadows supporting mixture of dry MG5 and M23 (in fields B and C). Field C is particularly rich supporting at the east: Genista tinctoria, Dactylorhiza fuchsii, Potentilla erecta, Pedicularis sylvetica and Succisa pratensis. The sward in A and C is tall, but drier areas are typified by Potentilla erecta, Stellaria graminea, Galium saxatile, Lotus corniculatus and Plantago lanceolata, together with some C.nigra and H.radicata. Field B becomes rank towards the west. Bracken is invading at some margins.
