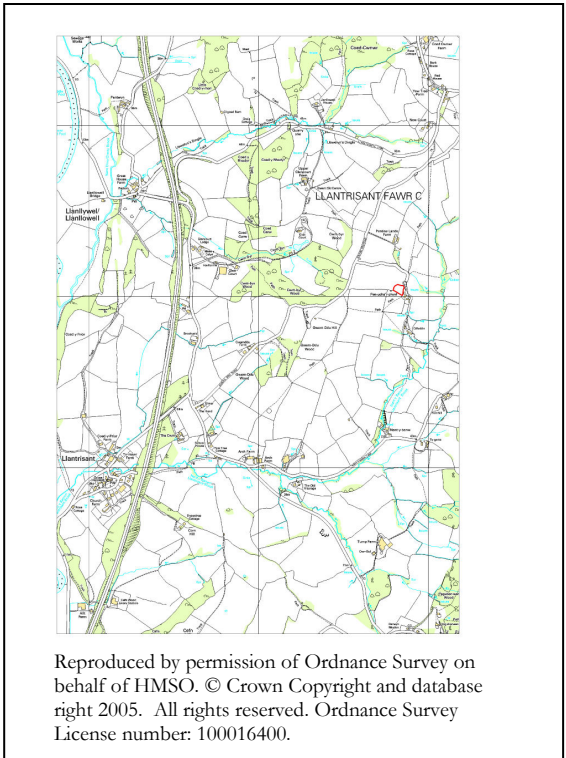

FULL DESCRIPTION OF SITE (including topography, adjacent land use, access and boundaries etc.):

The orchard is an area of land that slopes down to the east. It is surrounded by large trees (overgrown historically laid hedge) that is primarily Ash & Oak, together with smaller shrubs such as Hawthorn, Elder & Hazel. The orchard is mostly fenced but is open to an adjacent field. The orchard is overgrown by tall Bracken with occasional Nettle and Bramble patches. A good number of the trees (at least 7) are dead standing or dead fallen (those that are fallen are almost completely hidden by Bracken. A few veteran/quite old Apple (7) remain with one hollow and one with good amounts of Mistetoe. A number of new Apple (5), Pear (1) and Plum (1) have been planted and effort has been made to prevent these being choked by Bracken.

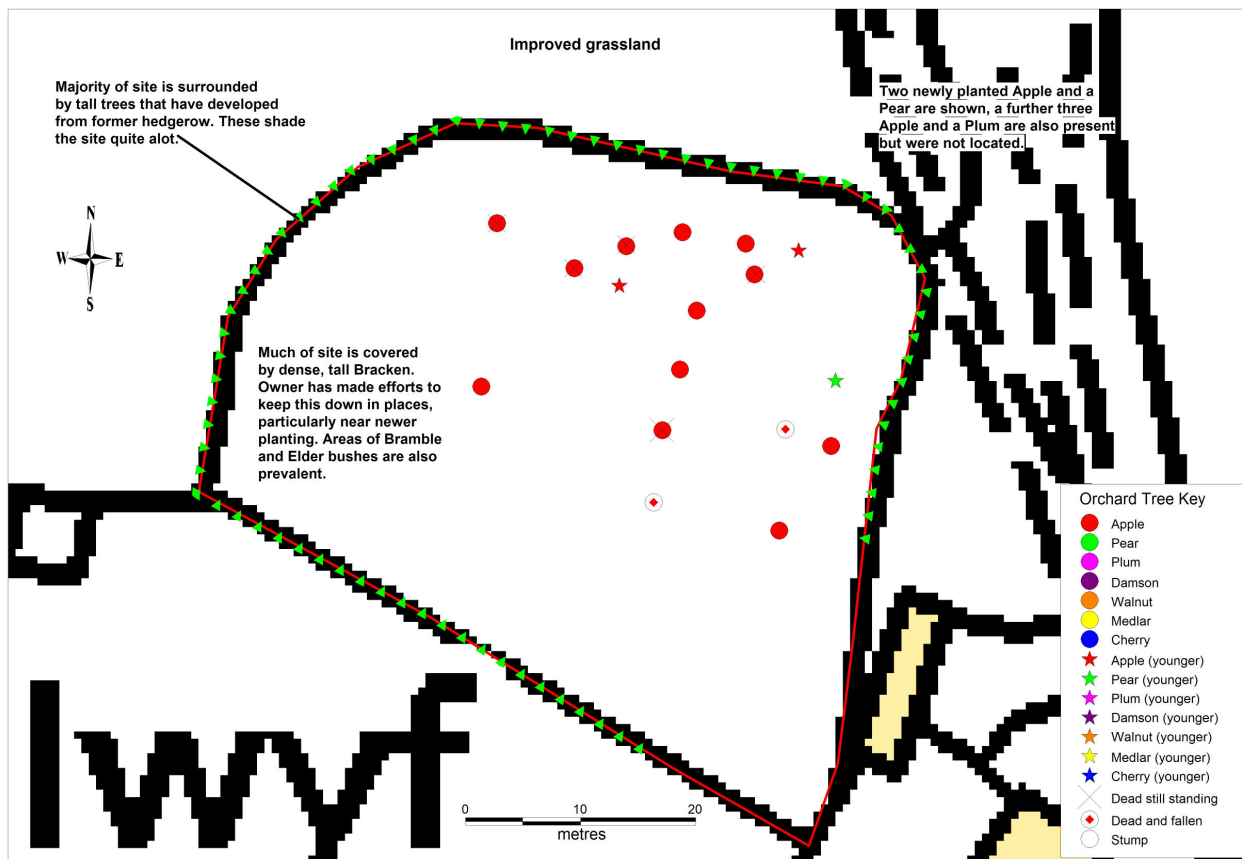
