WS/ST59/06	Matherm Mill	ST514916	1.34 ha	Marshy Grassland M23	Species Rich Grasslands (HAP)	Field to the west of Matherm Mill House is flanked by arable fields to west, a lane to the south and an Willow/Alder/Oak lined stream at the east. The site supports a marshy grassland community of varying structure with tall tussocky <i>Juncus effusus</i> and <i>Juncus inflexus</i> opening in places to shorter vegetation frequented by <i>Holcus lanatus</i> , <i>Lotus uliginosus</i> and <i>Mentha aquatica</i> . A variety of herbs are present though often not constant throughout the sward. <i>Caltha palustris</i> , <i>Lychnis flos-cuculi</i> , <i>Filipendula ulmaria</i> and <i>Galium palustre</i> are all locally frequent. The degree of wetness varies with <i>Scrophularia auriculata</i> , <i>Veronica beccabunga</i> and <i>Valeriana dioica</i> associated with wetter regions towards the north. <i>Rumex acetosa</i> is present throughout becoming particularly frequent in the site's drier swathes.
