27	Cnwc	Semi-upland fridd slopes supporting mainly bracken and an upland mountain top with areas of acid grassland and dry heathland. Wetter soils on the lower slopes support mosaics of marshy grassland, acidic flush and wet heath; wooded valleys with small areas of ancient woodland, and scattered mature trees on the bracken slopes. Two small disused reservoirs are present near the hilltop, one of which supports a regionally scarce plant.	H1, H4, H6, H7, H9, H10, H12, H15, H16, H20 H21 & H22. S6.	SO 00SE/8, David Clements Ecology Limited, May 2008. Resurveyed in October 2016 and SINC boundary retained.
