31	Cwm Fedw	Large area of grassland and wet woodland on ffridd slopes beside the course of the Nant-y-Fedw and running down into Cwm Bargod. Mainly semi-improved acid grasslands on the upper slopes, with semi-improved neutral grasslands and marshy grasslands on the lower slopes. The marshy grasslands are mainly rush-pastures, with a small area of fen-meadow also present. There is ancient semi-natural woodland along the course of the Nant-y-Fedw. The site also contains bracken slopes, acid flushes and small areas of both wet and dry heathland.	H1, H4, H6, H7, H9, H10, H12, H15, H20. S1 & S5.
