12	Cwm Glo/ Cwm-Glo a Glyndyrus	The SINC contains the Cwm-Glo a Glyndyrus SSSI which is of international significance for grassland fungi. Extensive areas of marshy grassland, species rich neutral grassland and acid grassland alongside woodland and heath supporting an impressive variety of protected, rare and uncommon species including marsh fritillary butterfly (<i>Euphydryas aurinia</i>), Great Crested Newt (<i>Triturus cristatus</i>), big blue pinkgill (<i>Entoloma bloxamii</i>) and olive earthtonge (<i>Microglossum olivaceum</i>).
