5	Clyn-mil/ Glynmil	Mosaic of semi-upland ffridd habitats at the western edge of Merthyr Common, partly on old colliery spoil tips. Comprises mainly unimproved and semi-improved acid grasslands, with smaller areas of marshy grassland, acid flush, dry acidic heath, bracken slopes and scrub. Also includes an area of ancient semi-natural oak woodland, and numerous smaller areas of wet woodland. Localised purple moor-grass pastures, with areas of acid flush and unimproved acid grassland, are present. Several ponds and numerous small streams run through the wooded areas.
