The bracken slopes support abundant bluebell. Also includes an area of wet heathland which extends along a ride within a conifer plantation and supports plant species of interest. The site supports a good range of breeding bird species and brown hare has also been recorded.	H1, H4, H6, H9, H10, H15, H20, H21, H22. S1.	SO 00SE/12, David Clements Ecology Limited, April 2008. Resurveyed in May 2017 and SINC retained and boundary amended to remove areas of new development.
