Supports a mosaic of habitats characteristic of dry acid soils, particularly unimproved and semi-improved acid grasslands, with bracken slopes and small areas of heathland gorse scrub. There are numerous outcrops of acidic rock and small disused quarries.	H1, H3, H4, H6, H9, H10, H20 & H21. S6.	SO 00SE/14, David Clements Ecology Limited, April 2008. Resurveyed in May 2016 and SINC boundary retained.
