The interesting, ungrazed ground flora and wooded cliff areas includes Purple Gromwell *Lithospermum purpurocaeruleum* which is restricted to a very small number of sites in the county.

The local Nature Reserve was declared in 1970 and is managed by the Vale of Glamorgan County Borough Council.
