**Site Area:** 68.8 ha

**Description:**

Fine cliff sections through Carboniferous Limestone sequence with evidence of strong earth movements and glacial deposits resting on a raised beach. Plant species with limited distribution in Britain, *Juniperus communis*, *Helianthemum canum*, *Potentilla tabernaemontani* and *Sorbus rupicola* occur in grassland at Newton Cliffs and Seven Slades.

**Remarks:**

Contiguous with the coastal section of Pwll Du Head and Bishopston Valley. Site of Special Scientific Interest, and includes a Glamorgan Naturalists' Trust Reserve at Redley Cliff. Within Gower AONB.
