Description:

This shallow mud-bottomed lake supports a number of rare plant species typical of the exposed mud of lake margins, e.g. orange foxtail *Alopecurus aequalis*, and pennyroyal *Mentha pulegium*. Of particular interest is the strange fern called pillwort *Pilularia globulifera*, endemic to Europe and a species threatened with extinction over most of its range by loss of its habitat. In spring and autumn the pool attracts wading birds on migration and in winter it is a resort for small numbers of teal and other waterfowl.
